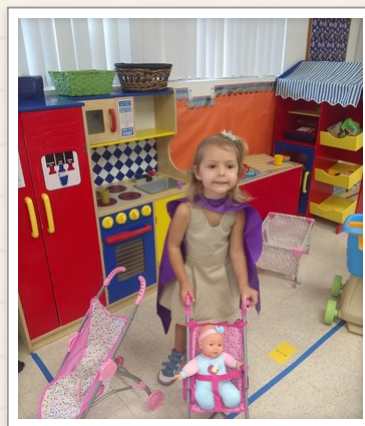
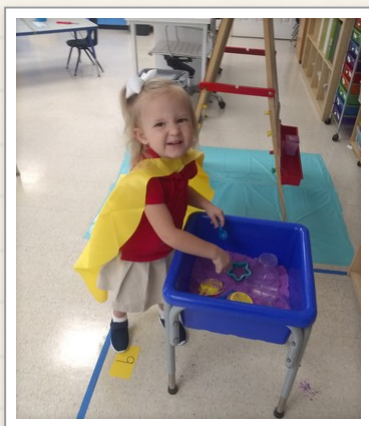
We are proud to let you all know that yard signs are now available in the front office. Please stop by and pick yours up today while supplies last!

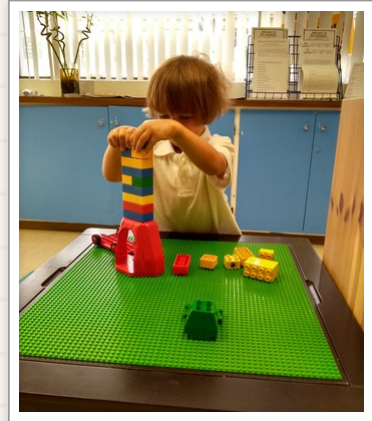
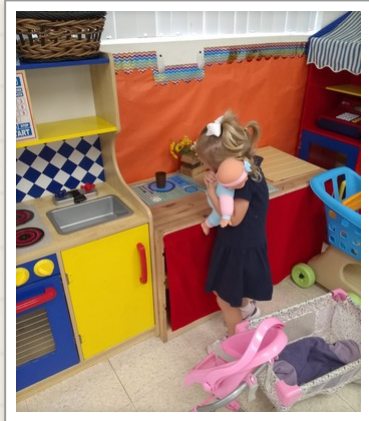
## Student Drop Off & Pick Up
