

I was sitting in my sophomore class, Literature 2, second period of the day. Our technology director came into our classroom to get television feed onto the projectors.

I remember being confused by what was happening. I quickly came to understand the term "terrorism" through the context of the news broadcast, but I was still confused. I had never heard of the World Trade Centers and couldn't figure out why those buildings were the ones being targeted.

I remember being confused, angry, sad, and bewildered. Words like "ground zero" and "tower" and "plane" and "firefighters" all have a different meaning to me now than they did before that day.














Tech Tip

Welcome back to school! As many of you are aware, Reformation is a G Suite for Education School. This means that all of the students are given Google accounts for use while they attend school.



In the upper grades, we use this for much of the homework the students have. The students who have Chromebooks also use this information to log in and use their devices. In the lower grades, the students are able to use their Google credentials to log in to Seesaw and other services that the teachers use with the students.

One of the benefits of using G Suite for Ed is that Reformation has complete control and can monitor what the students are doing while using these services and when they are on their Chromebooks.


