**Message from the Principal: Road to Emmaus**

News of Jesus' death had spread throughout Jerusalem and the surrounding area. During this time, two disciples were walking on the road from Jerusalem to Emmaus. They were obviously distraught as they were talking to a "stranger" about the events that happened over the last few days. They couldn't believe that Jesus was killed because he was not guilty, had performed miracles, and now they couldn't find their friend's body.

The stranger scolded them that they should know that this would happen to Jesus. He said to them, "How foolish you are, and how slow to believe all that the prophets have spoken! And beginning with Moses and all the Prophets, he explained to them what was said in all the Scriptures concerning himself."
