Principal's Message – Follow the Narrow Road

Luke 13: 24, "Jesus said to them, 'Make every effort to enter through the narrow door, because many, I tell you, will try to enter and will not be able to.'"

A coworker shared the WELS Daily Devotion with me from Thursday, Sept. 19. They thought this would be perfect for a message this week as our school theme is "Fix Your Eyes on Jesus!"

The devotion mentions traveling on a busy highway with too many lanes of traffic and not knowing when to exit, or not paying close enough attention to the right exit. I certainly experienced this for myself as my wife and I traveled to San Francisco for the first time this summer. I needed to get to Fisherman's Wharf, but rush hour traffic, a GPS, a brand new city to explore, and what seemed like a million other cars, all distracted me from finding the correct exit.

This is like life, the devotion goes on, that we can get swept up in "materialism and greed of our society" or "the sports-crazy culture" that eventually we are lead away from God and find our eyes focused on something else besides Jesus. So, let's recognize that the world pulls us in all sorts of directions, let's "turn on the GPS of God's Word" to refocus ourselves on Jesus, who lived, died, and rose again so that we can have the gift of eternal life in heaven.

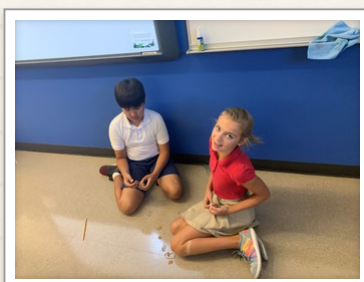

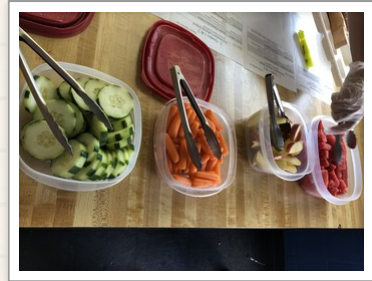
#RefTechTips

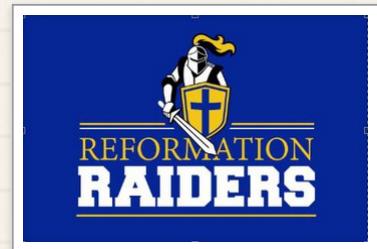


Update from Mr. Ash's 4th and 5th grade class
