### 2019 Basketball Sign-Up Information and Sign-up Sheet

This fall and winter, boys in grades 4-8 have the opportunity to play in a competitive basketball league at St. Paul's Lutheran School in Pacific Beach. This league is in addition to the daytime WELS school basketball games and is OPTIONAL. League play will begin most likely after Thanksgiving break and end early February. Games will be scheduled on Thursdays for the A Team and Tuesday or Thursdays for the B Team. There might be a few back-to-back games on those days as well. St. Paul's league games will begin at 4:00, 5:00, or 6:00 pm. The Boys B team will consist of boys in grades 4-6. The Boys A team will consist of boys in grades 6-8.

Practices for Boys B team will be held on Tuesdays and Thursdays from 2:15-3:15 pm. at Olive Grove Park (across the street from Reformation) or Reformation's gym. Tuesday and Thursday practices might run a little shorter if there are games scheduled. Practices for Boys A team will be held on Tuesdays and Thursdays from 2:15-4:00 pm at Olive Grove Park or Reformation's gym. Tuesday and Thursday practices may run a little shorter if there are games scheduled as well.

The cost for the league will be \$20 per player plus the cost of a basketball warm-up shirt (approximately \$25). Players will keep the shirt. Both will be billed together via FACTS. If your child has a warm-up shirt already and you do not wish to buy a new one, please note it on the sign up sheet, and you will not be charged for a new warm-up shirt. ### Parking Lot Help - Reminder!

We need your help in making the parking lot a safe place for everyone. Here are a few things that we see you can help with.

1. **Do not park in the handicap spots if you do not have the proper pass!** We are observing that cars are parking in these spots. Even if it's just for a few minutes, we have legitimate families who depend on being able to use these spots. We understand that parents want to use these spots as "safe"



places to quickly drop off their child(ren). However, cars are then not pulling all the way into the spots, which causes confusion to people walking and cars driving through the parking lot.

2. Please park in a spot even if you are just quickly "dropping off" your child(ren). We have observed this causing problems as it makes a line through the rest of the lot and makes it hard to quickly clear the spots for others to park in. You might consider dropping your child off on the street, then they can take the sidewalk that goes right past the office to the front gate.

3. It is worth the time AND the safety of the students of all ages to park fully in a spot, have your child exit the car and walk to the front gate.

We understand that the lot gets busy and many of you are trying to get to work and home, so if everyone helps out in these small ways, the parking lot will be a safe place for all. We greatly appreciate it!
