"No fair!" That's a pretty typical response from those who believe they're receiving the short end of the stick. "No fair!" will be the go-to response for unbelievers on the day Jesus returns in judgment. They won't like what Jesus has to say to them. They'll fight it, but their arguments won't win the day. Jesus' judgment is always fair and always right. His justice is perfect.

This is why we might be surprised at who faces his judgment on that epic day. Jesus once said, "Not everyone who says to me, 'Lord, Lord,' will enter the kingdom of heaven, but only the one who does the will of my Father who is in heaven. Many will say to me on that day, 'Lord, Lord, did we not prophesy in your name and in your name drive out demons and, in your name, perform many miracles?' Then I will tell them plainly, 'I never knew you. Away from me, you evildoers!"' (Matthew 7:21-23) Jesus isn't fooled by outward good deeds. Those can be faked. He searches people's hearts and looks for a humble faith that trusts in what he has done to save them, not in what they have done to save themselves. 


#### Tech Tip

#### Parking Lot Help - Reminder!

We need your help in making the parking lot a safe place for everyone. Here are a few things that we see you can help with.

1. <u>Do not park in the handicap spots if you do not have the proper pass!</u> We are observing that cars are parking in these spots. Even if it's just for a few minutes, we have legitimate families who depend on being able to use these spots. We



understand that parents want to use these spots as "safe" places to quickly drop off their child(ren). However, cars are then not pulling all the way into the spots, which causes confusion to people walking and cars driving through the parking lot.

- 2. Please park in a spot even if you are just quickly "dropping off" your child(ren). We have observed this causing problems as it makes a line through the rest of the lot and makes it hard to quickly clear the spots for others to park in. You might consider dropping your child off on the street, then they can take the sidewalk that goes right past the office to the front gate.
- 3. It is worth the time AND the safety of the students of all ages to park fully in a spot, have your child exit the car and walk to the front gate.

We understand that the lot gets busy and many of you are trying to get to work and home, so if everyone helps out in these small ways, the parking lot will be a safe place for all. We greatly appreciate it!


