The Boys B Basketball team also plays on Thursday, December 12, against Victory at 7:00 pm. Both games are played at St. Paul's Lutheran School in Pacific Beach. Basketball Sign-Up Information and Sign-up Sheet

This winter, girls in grades 4-8 have the opportunity to play in a competitive basketball league at St. Paul's Lutheran School in Pacific Beach. This league is in addition to the daytime WELS school basketball games and is OPTIONAL. During the regular season we will try to get everyone playing time. Please note that during tournaments and play-offs we will be playing our best players. We will try to play everyone during these games, but do not guarantee that everyone will play.

Reformation will have a Girls A and Girls B team. The A team will be coached by Mr. Bohl, and the Girls B team will be coached by Mrs. Homan. The Girls B team will consist of girls in grades 4-6. The Girls A team will consist of girls in grades 7-8 and possibly lower grades based by talent.

Practices for Girls B team will be held on Tuesdays and Thursdays from 2:15-3:15 pm at Reformation's gym or Olive Grove Park (across the street from Reformation). Tuesday and Thursday practices might run a little shorter if there are games scheduled. Practices for Girls A team will be held on Tuesdays and Thursdays from 2:15-4:15 pm at Olive Grove Park or Reformation's gym. Tuesday and Thursday practices may run a little shorter if there are games scheduled as well.

League play will begin sometime in February. Games are scheduled Tuesdays and/or Thursdays. There might be a few back-to-back games on those days as well. Games at St. Paul's league will begin at 4:00, 5:00, or 6:00 pm. We understand that not all parents can drive to games, but it is your job to make sure your daughter has a ride. Mrs. Homan and Mr. Bohl will be taking girls, but you will have to check with them to see if they have room. If you cannot find a ride, you can put a note out on our Shutterfly account that your daughter needs a ride.

The cost for the league per player will be \$20 for plus the cost of a basketball warm-up shirt (approximately \$25). Players will keep the shirt. Both will be billed together via FACTS. If your child still has their warm-up from last year, they do not need to buy a new one.
