Excusable absences are those resulting from illness, medical, dental, optometric appointment, or bereavement. Examples of non-excusable absences are absence from school to run errands for parents, absence from school to help care for children, absence from school because of family travel or vacation plans unless pre-approved by the principal. Planned absence from school for any reason will be marked as "unexcused" unless the Planned absence form has been submitted to the principal at least 2 weeks prior to the planned absence. Submitting the form does not guarantee that the absence will be excused. Other factors such as the students grades, their ability to keep pace with their class, their history for missing work, and the reason for the absence will be considered before the absence will be excused.

All classes and assignments missed during non-excusable absences will be given a grade of a "0%".
