This month in the 2 ½ and 3 year-old classroom the children are off to great places; meeting new friends, learning how to use their words, sharing and learning how to play with each other. The day begins with the calendar, practicing the months of the year and days of the week. During large motor activities we are focusing on ABC movements, running like airplanes, bouncing like bunnies, and crawling like cats. Each week more letters will be added. Back in the classroom the theme is "All about Me". The children are working on tracing their names with pom-poms and other materials, counting how many letters are in their name,

getting to know the names of the children in the classroom and making charts of different eye colors, hair colors and letters in their names. Music time is always so much fun singing and dancing. Some of their favorite songs are “Jesus Loves Me”, “Head, Shoulders, Knees, and Toes”, and “If You’re Happy and You Know It”. As the month continues, the children will learn about different emotions and feelings, colors and counting.
